CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of the Research

As we know that English is an international language, the language used to communicate with other people almost around the world. Most of countries in the world oblige their communities master in English, and make English as a subject that must be learn in schools. In fact, some countries make English as their second mother tongue.

By mastering listening skill means the students had prepared their skill in receiving information. Because if we want to know the information we have to know what is the problem and then try to understand it. But mastering listening is difficult for students because they find many unfamiliar words. It can make students do not understand the meaning of the material.

As long as the researcher know when do PLP program (Pengenalan Lapangan Persekolahan) in SMA Muhammadiyah Kudus in the academic year 2019/2020, some student very like and very enthusiastic with English subject in their school, sometimes they like listening music, watching movie and read English book such as novel, comics, etc. But on other hand English can be scary thing for them, how it can be? Because the main problem for them is difficult to remember the meaning of the sentence and they difficult to say the pronunciation, they don't know how to say with correct grammar and one more small problem, in the other hand they less in listening skill too, as we know that listening skills is the ability to comprehend verbally communicated information and providing appropriate feedback. It can be described also as the ability to pay attention to sound. According to English (2009) listening skill in many classrooms are taught with the traditional classroom setting with rows of desks and chairs symbolic of the type of learning that is based in

Passive listening. It is important to teacher to find another way in teaching listening skill that suitable with students' interest, one of the techniques is by using music or song.

Using English song in the classroom is one of the media how teacher can teach student with enjoying the class, so the student more interesting to study in English, they can improve their own ability with their favorite music, especially in their listening skill. However, songs can present a problem, particularly with teenage students; because it is often difficult to know exactly which songs the students like at any particular time, and which songs, very popular last week have suddenly gone (Harmer, 2007, p.320). Murphey (1990) suggests that many English teachers have long recognized that song and music work well in language classes. The statement shows that teachers can use song as a media to overcome the students difficulties in listening and improve their listening ability. Brand & Li (2009) advocated that using song lyrics in helping to create a natural speaking environment that more closely to the intercultural communication skills is necessary for students to understand English and to be understood by others.

1.2 Statement of the Research
