CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of the Research

Language is a device to communicate with others. English have 4 skills to master by the students, they are: listening, speaking, reading, and writing.

Pollard (2008:34) states that speaking is one of the most difficult aspects for students to master. According to Ur (1996: 117) there are four problems that are often faced by the students in learning speaking, they are: inhibition, nothing to say, low or uneven participation, and mother tongue use. For example, many students are lack of the necessary vocabulary to get their meaning across, as the consequence they cannot keep the interaction going.

The problems above also happen in SMA PGRI 1 Pati. When the writer did PLP in SMA PGRI 1 Pati, the writer found that there are problems in students' speaking skill. The writer found that students had good score in reading, listening and writing, but they cannot speak English fluently. The teachers said that speaking is the students' weakness. When the teacher give them practice to speak English almost the students show their uninterested and laziness in speaking practise.
