#### **CHAPTER I**

#### INTRODUCTION

In this chapter, the writer presents background of the research, statement of the problem, objective of the research, significance of the research, scope of the research, and operational definition.

# 1.1 Background of the Research

Vocabulary is mainly associated with words that known by an individual or a group of people. Vocabulary may designate an object in which a collection of words is explained. Wilkins (1972) said, "...while without grammar very little can be conveyed, without vocabulary *nothing* can be conveyed" (pp. 111-112). These random words are important as they represent a natural function of speech, and students can benefit from learning these words and applying a new context and meaning for them (Brown, 2007).

Wrenshall (2002) said, "there is also plenty of evidence that song help memorization, and the rhythm and rhyme of the lyrics can certainly help vocabulary as well." (p. 43). Songs are easy to find nowadays, we can find it in the television, music player, and YouTube. Songs are way more fun and familiar to the students' ears.

The students of SMA N 2 Kudus is lack of vocabulary mastery because the condition in the classroom when they learn English subject does not match with their characteristics in daily life. In fact, the eleventh grade students of SMA N 2 Kudus have to be able to master the English vocabulary to communicate with other people who are not from their area.

Learning vocabulary can be more effective if there is an appropriate media in teaching and learning vocabulary.
