A. Objectives

The students are able to:

- 1. Change verb in the present tense to past tense form
- 2. Find out the mistake verb in the sentences
- 3. Find out the mistake verb in the recount text

Mistake Buster Technique

- **D.** Procedure of Teaching
- 1. Pre-activity

- a. Orientation: Preparing the students to study
 - Greeting
 - Checking the attendance list
- b. Apperception: Giving the students some questions leading to the topic will be taught
- c. Motivation: Making the students interest in learning

2. While-activity

- a. Exploration:
- Tell students they are going to have an activity to review the Simple Past Tense.
- Divide the class into two teams and tell them they are going to compete in the activity.
- Make two columns on the white board and ask students to fill the left column with many verbs in the Present Tense.
- Tell them they have to find the past tense forms for all the verbs. They have to raise their hands quickly to get the permission to give an answer. For each correct answer, the team will score ten points.
- Begin the activity and add up the scores for each team when all the verbs have been changed to the Simple Past Tense.
- b. Elaboration
- Tell students that they have to listen to short sentences and then long sentences to find the mistakes in the verbs and correct them by putting them in the Simple Past Tense.
- Start reading one sentence at a time. Repeat the sentence if they did not understand it the first time.
- Tell students they are going to listen to a recount and write down the verbs they think are wrong.
- Read the narrative at a normal speed once.
- Read it again if necessary.
- They have to raise their hands quickly to get the permission to give an answer.

- c. Confirmation
- Students have to raise their hands quickly to get the permission to give an answer. For each correct answer, the team will score ten points.
- Keep scores and add them up after all sentences have been read and corrected.
- Ask them to say out loud the wrong verbs they heard and the correction as well.
- Keep score and add them up when all the verbs have been corrected.

3. Post-activity

- a. Praise students for their efforts.
- Review important points or give more explanation if necessary.
- c. The teacher makes the summary
- d. The teacher gives the explanation for the next topic
- e. Parting

Simple past tense is to express the past event in the past time in the definite time and to retell the past event.

Simple past tense is divided into two forms, verbal and nominal.

Verbal form:

$$(+) S + V2 + O + adv$$

(-)
$$S + did + not + V1 + O + adv$$

(?)
$$Did + S + V1 + O + adv$$
?

Nominal form:

(+) S + was/were + adj/noun/adv

(-) S + was/were + not + adj/noun/adv

(?) Was/were + S + adj/noun/adv?

Example:

1. (+) I studied English last night.

(-) I didn't study English last night.

(?) Did I study English last night?

2. (+) I was beautiful

(-) I was not beautiful

(?) Was I beautiful?

Verb 2 is divided into two; they are regular and irregular verb

Regular verb: play – played – played

Irregular verb: go – went – gone

Time signal:

Yesterday, last night, last week, last month, last year, the day before, ago, at that time, in the past, in the early time, in 1945, etc


CAMPING
