CHAPTER I

And using technology tools 'to think with' facilitates working with ideas and learning from that process" Scardamalia, (2002)

Reading is an essential part of language learning in every level. Reading activities support the learners in learning English in several ways. For instance, the learners may do reading activities in order to master the language. In this case, they use reading material as a language input. By giving students the reading materials, the teachers provide opportunities for students to gain vocabulary, grammar, sentence structure, and others. Moreover, for Indonesian students, this is a bridge in understanding scientific books. Since they have lack of knowledge in English, they often encounter difficulties in reading English books. In education, reading skill is one of the requirements for the students to comprehend the material during the learning process. For instance, when the
