CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of the Study

In learning English, there are four skills that should be mastered by English language learners. The skills are listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Listening is anything but it is a passive activity because most of people especially students are passive in listening English, they think that listening English is difficult subject. Some problems that usually faced in the listening session of typical Indonesian learners are the unfamiliarity with the kind of listening test. There are many methods with different media for teaching listening comprehensions, such as audio like English songs, conversation like dialog or monolog. And video that provides students with audio and interesting visual effect. So, in teaching especially listening has to use appropriate media and method to attract the students' interest.

English songs are often used in learning process. The main purposes for using songs are both for introducing and improving English language. It is because songs offer great assistances in developing English language. As cited from Berne (2004), listening is the first encounter with the target language in language learning journey. Listening activities are also required in academic context, where the students have to deal with listening comprehension in the class. The importance of finding listening strategy also suggest by Wallace et al. (2004), he states that experience with a variety of reading, writing and speaking activities in school can help learners acquire the skills they need to be successful.

Rost (1994:148) says that listening can be taught as component skills. Since listening involves an integration of several component skills such as recognizing words, identifying stressed words and grouping of words, intonation, stress, gesture, and relevant objects in the situation in order to construct meaning, using background knowledge, teacher can design specific learning activities and find a suitable technique to teach listening to the students.

One of the most important aspects in teaching English is listening. Many students has the same problem for learning English listening such as lack of vocabulary, understanding the grammatical, unsuitable media that used by teacher, and etc. This problem should be solved by teacher, teachers have to find the suitable and effective strategy, method, technique, and also media to make students understand and interest in learning English listening. The media which are used by the teacher is using English songs, video, many paper with the listening section, watching some of the story, fable, or legend, also listening what the teacher says.
