

CHAPTER 1

INTRODUCTION

This chapter discussed the background of the research, statement of the problem, objective of the research, significance of the research, limitation of the research, and operational definition.

1.1 Background of the Research

Learning is a process of behavior change thanks to experience and practice. This means that the purpose of the activity is a change in behavior, whether it involves knowledge, skills, or attitudes even covering all aspects of the organism or person (Djamarah and Zain, 2010). Indonesia has implemented compulsory education for 12 years, starting from Elementary School, Junior High School, and Senior High Schools. Even parents often put their children in the playgroup first. It is to prepare their children before entering elementary school. This is related to Suprijono (2010) which stated learning is the process of gaining knowledge.

Sudjana (2010) explained that learning is a process marked by a change in a person. Changes in the results of the learning process can be shown in various forms such as the addition of knowledge, understanding, attitudes and behavior, skills, habits, and other aspects of changes that exist in individuals who learn. This has been applied in Indonesia which has implemented curriculum 13 which covers various aspects, such as spiritual, social, knowledge, and skills aspects.

Learning does not have to be at school. We can study at home by homeschooling. Even outside school hours, we can learn by observing the environment around us. Even now it has also been implemented online-based learning or can be called e-learning.

Ardiansyah (2013) stated E-learning is a learning system that is used as a means is as a teaching and learning process carried out without having to face to face directly between educators and students. In the sense that we do not attend class by going to school or building, even at home we can access E-learning. The other word is the opposite of a face-to-face class, which is an online class.

1.2 Statement of the Problem
