CHAPTER 1 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of the Research

Idioms (idiomatic expressions) are a type of informal language in which the meaning of the words in the expression is different from the meaning of the words in the expression. In Oxford Advanced Learner's Dictionary (2010), it is stated that idiom is group of words whose meaning is different from the meanings of the individual words. As cited in Butarbutar, (2020) argues that idiomatic expressions (idioms) are multi-word phrases which that combines the literal senses of the individual words in each phrase.
