CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

In this chapter, the researcher explains background of the research, statement of the problem, objective of the research, significance of the research, scope of the research, and operational definition.

1.1 Background of The research

Language is important for people in the world. The language cannot be separated from people because it is means of communication. The people use it to communicate with others in society. Therefore, English has been approved as one of the international languages. Most of people in the world, including in Indonesia, learn English in formal education.
