1.1. Background of the Research

Besides presentation, The importance of interaction is equal to that of presentation. The lecturer's information will be more effective if the class's interactive lesson communication is maintained. Interaction in the classroom improves students' grasping power and will increase their grasping power more than passively listening to the lecturer's topic.

In a prior study conducted by Sadeeq et all (2021), participants in the statistics course came from four distinct private and government universities, including Koya University (KU), Salahuddin University (SU), Chihan University (CU), and Lebanese French University (LFU). The findings of this study demonstrate appropriate communication patterns in educational environments, which may be beneficial to the teaching process in education.
