CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

In this chapter, the researcher discusses about background of the research, statement of the problem, objective of the research, significance of the research, scope of the research and operational definition.

1.1 Background of the Research

Listening is one aspect of English that emphasizes the understanding of listening to the language, either directly or through media such as music or movies. There are many problems faced by students in listening, including lack of mastery of vocabulary and pronunciation, the number of accents in English, lack of concentration and wrong learning strategies. Yefridelti (2018) found many problems faced by student in listening, there are lack of knowledge English, lack of vocabulary, lack of Students' English communication exercises in everyday life, low activity of understanding English, low quality of student tasks, and lack of techniques used by teachers.

Learning media is very necessary to help students to facilitate the learning process. Learning media also has a very important role in increasing student motivation and achievement during the learning process. Media can make the learning process more interest and clear (Putra & Sujana, 2020). One of the learning media that can be used is YouTube.

YouTube is an application containing a wide variety of videos. YouTube allows users to upload, watch and share videos. YouTube is very easy to use only requires an internet connection and students can access it anywhere and anytime. YouTube provides a variety of learning and entertainment videos. Students can search for videos of learning materials by simply typing keywords. Students can also download videos, so if there is no internet connection students can still play videos that have already been downloaded. The use of YouTube for teachers as a learning media is

also very easy. The teacher only needs to copy the URL of the material video and send it to the students. This video media will stimulate students feeling, thoughts and willingness to learn through audio-visual presentation of ideas and information (Muskania, Badariah, & Mansur, 2019)

By implementing learning based on the YouTube, it can encourage students to become independent in learning and the students will get used to thinking critically. Moreover, YouTube based learning knowledge and the development of students' insight can improve learning outcomes, so the implications for the quality of education will also improve.

Although it has the advantage of being accessible in leisure time and being able to replay learning, YouTube also has the disadvantage of this learning process, namely students who live in places that are not reached by the internet or find it difficult to access the internet, this problem will make it difficult for students because the videos watched are not smooth or often paused. Rasman (2021) said the shortcomings of YouTube as a learning media are a poor internet network and unclear video resolution.

In the previous research Ririn et.al (2021) concludes the students' perception of using YouTube in vocabulary mastery give most positive perception. Most students agree that YouTube help them improve their English vocabulary and also help them to enrich their vocabulary each day. Not only that, they also agreed that using YouTube in vocabulary mastery get the positive impact in English learning process even in the class environment. According to Rahayu and Linna (2021) YouTube offers a significant effect on students in the use of online video as a learning media. The research also revealed that students' interest in using YouTube in their lesson. It means that this application is the right platform to making learning process becomes fun and attracts the attention of students.

Based on the background that has been described, the researcher wants to explore about students' perception in listening using YouTube at the eleventh grade students of SMA N 1 MAYONG because YouTube is in high demand in all circles, also easy to operate and makes it more interesting

to see videos of songs and give so much new vocabulary in a fun appearance on that app.
