

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

ABSTRACT

English is the international language. Teaching English requires ideas and strategies according to the pedagogy of each teacher. This study aims to find out the internship students' strategies in teaching speaking and the reasons internship students used the strategies. This study used qualitative and open-ended interviews as instruments. 5 eight-semester English education department students of Muria Kudus University as participants in the interview. The results of this study are that there are 5 strategies used by participants, namely brainstorming, tongue twister, questioning, dialogue and discussion. the reason for using the chosen strategy is that students are not easily bored and sleepy in class, and students can actively speak English during the lesson. Hopefully this research can be useful for students, and future researchers. After reading this research, students know the strategies used in teaching speaking, and for further researchers are expected to use this research as a reference.

Bahasa Inggris adalah bahasa internasional. Pengajaran bahasa Inggris memerlukan ide dan strategi sesuai dengan pedagogi masing-masing guru. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui strategi mahasiswa magang dalam mengajar berbicara dan alasan mahasiswa magang menggunakan strategi tersebut. Penelitian ini menggunakan instrumen wawancara kualitatif dan terbuka. 5 mahasiswa jurusan pendidikan bahasa Inggris Universitas Muria Kudus semester delapan sebagai peserta wawancara. Hasil dari penelitian ini terdapat 5 strategi yang digunakan peserta yaitu brainstorming, twister lidah, bertanya, dialog dan diskusi. alasan penggunaan strategi yang dipilih adalah agar siswa tidak mudah bosan dan mengantuk di kelas, serta siswa dapat aktif berbicara bahasa Inggris selama pembelajaran. Semoga penelitian ini dapat bermanfaat bagi mahasiswa, dan peneliti selanjutnya. 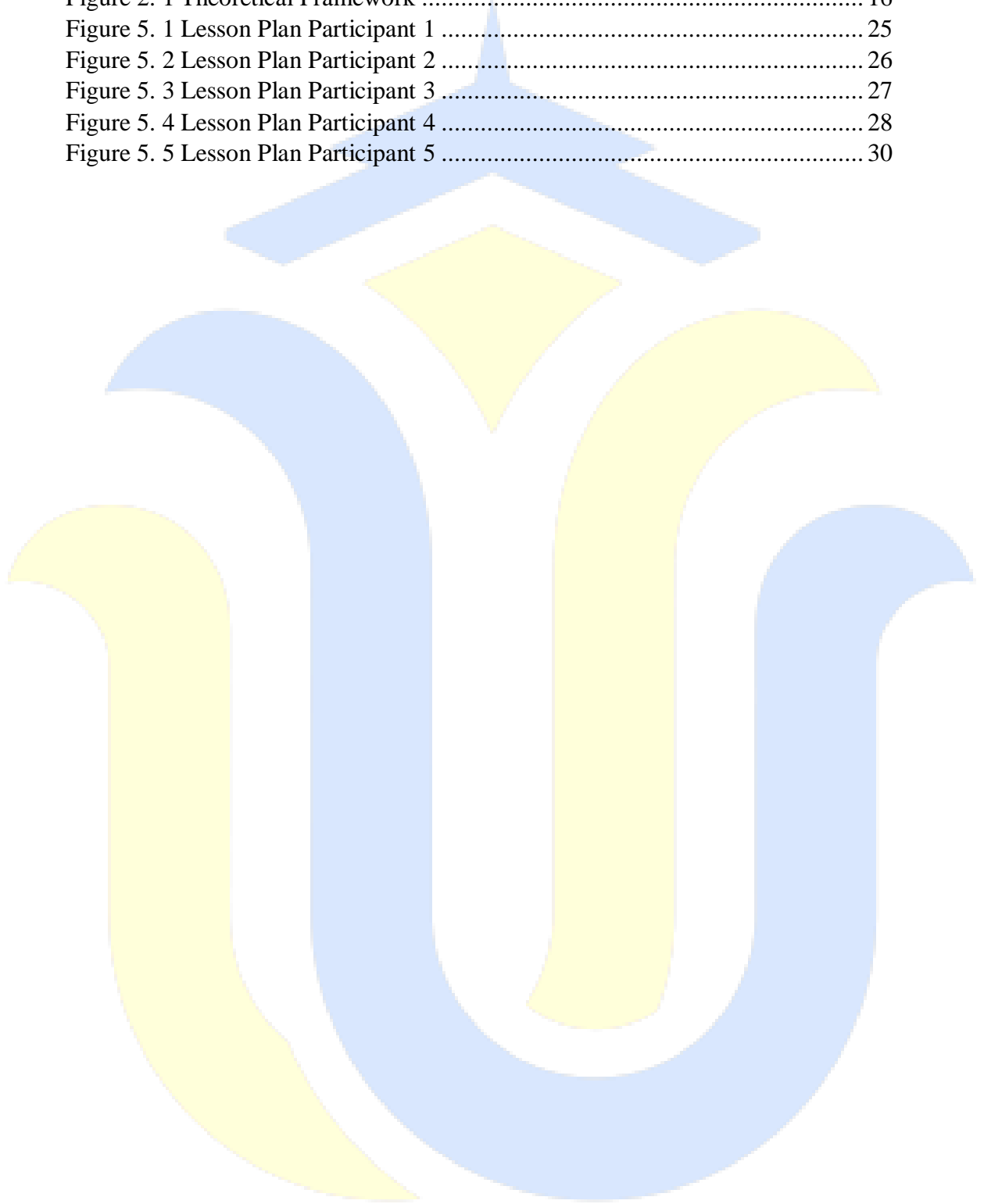
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
