CHAPTER I

Gumus mentioned that some problems are faced by learners when they are writing and it can cause writing difficulties. Those are pre-writing difficulties such as the selection of the topic of writing: organizational difficulties and vocabulary difficulties, and technical difficulties such as grammar, punctuation, and spelling (Gumus, 2019).

Writing is a communication tool to convey the author's ideas to the reader's audience. Jack C. Richard and Willy A. Renandya revealed in our global culture that the ability to write effectively is becoming increasingly crucial, and writing instruction is increasingly significant in both second and foreign language education. Writing is one of the productive skills because it builds words or sentences such as paragraphs or text. Thus, writing has an important role in language learning and is often measured as the success of foreign language learning. Therefore, high school students need to master writing skills.
