CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background Of the Research

Vocabulary is not only an important component of language expression but also the most basic application of language content. For most learners, the breadth and depth of vocabulary will affect listening, speaking, reading, writing, and translation levels, therefore, teaching vocabulary becomes very important (Gao, 2021). The study of vocabulary is a crucial component of learning English. The development of one's vocabulary is crucial to language learning, claims that a person's vocabulary is the collection of terms they are familiar with. The aforementioned phrase suggests that each person needs to expand their vocabulary on their own. It's harder to expand your vocabulary in English than it is in Indonesian. The pronunciation, usage, writing, and meaning of these terms are where the trouble lies (Panjaitan, 2021). In education, teaching and learning vocabulary is an important part, especially in learning a foreign language as the meaning of a new word. It's almost impossible to learn a foreign language without learning vocabulary.

Based on her research Hayati, (2021) A teacher's teaching strategy is one of the additional components that will complement their work in the classroom. Teaching strategies play a crucial role in the process of teaching and learning. Because students are learning by doing, the classroom activities will not be boring and the learners' goals will be successfully attained. It can also assist teachers in facilitating the learning activities of their students. There are several ways that teachers can use this to make the teaching and learning process more effective and interesting. According to Panjaitan, (2021) The use of teaching strategies in English will have an impact on students' vocabulary levels. Since some students have no interest in studying English, teaching methods will have an impact on students' motivation. The teacher can grab students' attention and help them reach their objectives by using relevant and effective teaching strategies. According to Khaliq, (2023) The teacher can modify other components of the lesson plan to

create variants. However, the instructor cannot be controlled by the other elements of the teaching strategy the student is the element that completes the study program to increase capacity for studying the objective serves as the foundation for choosing the appropriate teaching method, curriculum, media, and evaluation. Based on that statement teacher strategies holding important aspect in learning English. Students need the right strategy in learning English. Students need the right strategies to learn English. With the teacher strategies that EFL teachers have, they will be more effective and improve English language learning in the classroom. However, choosing the right teacher strategy also influences classroom learning. Therefore, teachers' strategies were closely observed by several other studies.

Based on my observations at SMA Muhammadiyah Kudus, especially in the class Eleventh Grade Social Department, students still experience great difficulties in English subjects. As usual, this is caused by students' lack of vocabulary in English. This is very influential in learning English where vocabulary is important in learning and understanding English. If students lack English vocabulary, this will affect students' English skills. As we know, skills in English consist of speaking, writing, reading and listening. Students experience great difficulty in mastering all these skills and this is closely related to vocabulary mastery. It is true that there are some students who have mastered some of these English skills, but this is driven by students' interest in English and also students who study outside school hours. Students experience difficulties if the teacher directs students to read, speak, write and listen. In this case, students find it difficult because for them it is something new to learn. Not a few students are confident if students are assigned to read, speak, write and listen because of the lack of vocabulary in English. Seeing the problems above, students need appropriate vocabulary learning strategies. The selection of appropriate teacher strategies influences learning. Based on the observations above, teacher strategies have an important role in the learning process or learning English. Teachers are required to be able to understand students' situations during the learning process. Teachers must prepare the best strategies in teaching vocabulary so that they can increase students' vocabulary, with the best strategies students can receive vocabulary learning well. Based on this case, there are also many students who don't know how to increase vocabulary in learning English because they feel that increasing vocabulary is difficult to do. So teachers have to be creative in making methods on how to make appropriate strategies to increase vocabulary. This research is different from previous research because this research focuses on the teaching strategies of the teachers there.

Firstly Khaliq, (2023) Based on the collecting of the data, the researcher concluded that the material used by the English teacher is the Jobs such as (1) Astronaut, (2) Shop assistant, Etc. The media used by English teachers were pictures. Then, the strategies used by the teacher were: presentation, practicing, and explaining.

The second research by Deni & Fahriany, (2020) referring to research, this research is very different in that this research focuses on the teacher's perspective on vocabulary teaching strategies. while my research focuses on the teaching strategies possessed by a teacher. I believe every teacher has his or her own effective teaching strategy and The results of this study reveal that teachers believe that teaching strategies are important in teaching vocabulary to young learners. So, teachers vary the strategies that can be applied to teach vocabulary to young learners, for example by using games, singing a song, and so on. Apart from that, teachers also use interesting media such as videos, real objects, pictures, and so on.

The third previous by Khadawardi, (2022) The results indicated that watching movie clips with subtitles had an effective learning result and a positive impact on student's motivation to learn L2 vocabulary. I have read this research and I think it is very different from the research I would have done, where this research focuses on how effective vocabulary teaching is using animated film clips with English subtitles. Meanwhile, the research that I will carry out is regarding the teaching strategies that EFL teachers have and use in teaching subjects at school. Of course, these two things are very different and cannot be said to be the same.

1.2 Statements Of Problem
