ABSTRACT

This research aims to explain the language styles used in the dialogues within the "Look and Say" section of the *My Next Words Grade 5 Student's Book for Elementary School*.

The theoretical framework for this study is based on Joos's language style theory (1967), which categorizes language into five different styles: frozen, formal, consultative, casual, and intimate. Additionally, Holmes's theory (2013) on the functions of language styles, including expressive, directive, referential, and phatic functions, is used to analyze the communicative purposes of these styles.

The research employs a qualitative methodology to examine the dialogues in the "Look and Say" section (Roller, 2019). Data collection involves documenting and analyzing dialogues from the student book using the aforementioned theories.

After analyzing the dialogues, the researcher found that all 23 dialogues in the data source use a casual language style (100%). The analysis also highlights that out of 23 dialogues, 13 expressive (57%), 5 referential (22%), 4 directive (17%), and only one phatic (4%) function are the most frequently used, emphasizing the importance of emotional engagement and information delivery in educational dialogues.

In conclusion, this study reveals that the only language styles used in the "look and say" part of the *My Next Words Grade 5 Student's Book for Elementary School* book. While educators should consider using a more diverse range of language styles to enhance variation in language use and its functions. Further research could explore the application of these findings in different educational contexts and with other instructional media.

Penelitian dengan judul *Language Styles of The Dialogues In "Look and Say" Part of My Next Words Grade 5 Student's Book for Elementary School* ini, bertujuan untuk menjelaskan apa gaya bahasa yang digunakan dalam dialog pada bagian "Look and Say" dalam buku *My Next Words Grade 5 Student's Book for Elementary School*.

Kerangka teori untuk studi ini didasarkan pada teori gaya bahasa Joos (1967), yang mengkategorikan bahasa ke dalam lima gaya yang berbeda: beku, formal, konsultatif, kasual, dan intim. Selain itu, teori Holmes (2013) tentang fungsi gaya bahasa, yang mencakup fungsi ekspresif, direktif, referensial, dan fatis, digunakan untuk menganalisis tujuan komunikatif dari gaya-gaya ini.

Penelitian ini menggunakan metodologi kualitatif untuk mengkaji dialog dalam bagian "Look and Say". Pengumpulan data melibatkan dokumentasi dan analisis dialog(Roller, 2019) dari buku siswa menggunakan teori tersebut

Setelah melalui dokumentasi dan analisis dialog, peneliti menemukan bahwa sebagian besar dialog dalam sumber data menggunakan gaya bahasa kasual yang efektif dalam melibatkan siswa dan memfasilitasi pemahaman. Analisis juga menunjukkan bahwa fungsi ekspresif dan referensial adalah yang paling sering digunakan, menyoroti pentingnya keterlibatan emosional dan penyampaian informasi dalam dialog pendidikan.

Kesimpulan dari penelitian ini adalah pendidik mempertimbangkan penggunaan gaya bahasa yang lebih beragam untuk meningkatkan variasi dalam penggunaan gaya bahasa dan fungsinya. Penelitian lebih lanjut dapat mengeksplorasi penerapan temuan ini dalam konteks pendidikan yang berbeda dan dengan media ajar lain.


