1.1 Background of the Research

Taboos can also bring shame, disgrace, and harsh treatment from the environment. Wardhaugh (2000) says that taboo is a prohibition or avoidance that cannot be used by humans in any society because it would hurt its members and make they feel anxious, embarrassing, or embarrassed.

Taboo is one aspect of social structure that reflects language and actions. Taboo words are which is considered unpleasant and is better avoided because it mentions an obvious fact or vulgar. And taboos also represent human experience or what is happening around and within they are certainly very closely related to the culture of the community (listeners), especially in this study to choose song lyrics that have language quality to develope children's thinking skills in lyrics from Rich Brian taboo words can refer to gender, religion, exposure to body parts and violence or excretion.

Many taboo words have been used in songs especially in Rap songs. Rap is a genre of music that is spoken faster than it really is, songs usually with electronic rhythm accompaniment or other musical instruments. This type of music is widely used and liked by many people, especially young people. One of the reason why young people like rap music is because rap music is lifestyle and covers all classes of youth and also becomes an arena for young people to show off their skills or just sing. The lyrics are expressive, straightforward and loud which certainly suits them, young and vibrant. That's why many young people like this type of music. Especially in this Rich Brian song, contain so many taboo words and also most of the songs are rap music, which is that young people's are need it.

He is a rapper from Indonesia who graduated from 88rising who recently became famous for his single titled Dat Stick which was first released in February 2016. His studio album debut, *Amen*, was released on 2018 and got the 18 rank on billboard 200 United States.

1.7.3 Dat Stick Song

Rich Brian (formerly known as Rich Chigga), a stage name for viral Vine star, Brian Immanuel, released "Dat Stick" in early 2016. In this months following it's release, the 16-year-old rapper from Jakarta, Indonesia and his music video wen't viral. "Dat Stick" also received additional recognition when a reaction video of popular rappers responding to the song was released. The video features artist such as *Desiigner*, *Tory Lanez*. And *Ghostface Killah*, who actually hopped on the official remix to "Dat Stick" alongside pouya. After this song was released, many kind of respons from people. There is a two kind of reaction to this *Dat Stick* Video music, as Rich Brian using his stage name "Rich Chigga". Some people put a compliment over him, and some of them criticize, and put a highlight to the lyrics of his song "Nigga" in a Dat Stick song. Chigga is a acronym from Chinese-Nigga.
