

CHAPTER III

RESEARCH METHOD

Research method is a way employed by me to collect and analyze the data in order to solve the problem. In this chapter, I describe design of the study, data and data source, data collection, and data analysis.

3.1 Design of the Study

This study is Qualitative research. Silverman (2004:136) states that "Qualitative research studies include ethnographies, case studies, and typically, descriptive studies. Qualitative research methods typically include interviews, historical and document analyses, and observation". Qualitative research will not give the numeral or statistic but it depends on the knowledge of the researcher about the material in analyzing data because the data are reported in utterances.

3.2 Data and Data Source

In this study, the data is utterance of illocutionary acts and the utterance of the movie script is the data source. I downloaded the data source in <http://www.imsdb.com/scripts/Remember-Me.html>. This movie scripts is written by William Fettes and Jenny Lumet that revised in April 16th 2009. I analyze the utterances that produce by the main characters in Remember Me movie scripts. They are Robert Pattinson (Tyler) and Emilie de Ravin (Ally).

3.3 Data Collection

The technique of collecting the data applied in this study is by using several types as follow:

1. I watch the Remember Me movie.
2. I download Remember Me movie script by internet in <http://www.imsdb.com/scripts/Remember-Me.html>

3.4 Data Analysis

After collecting data, I analyze the data. To make easier in reporting the data, I use some ways:

1. Read the Remember Me movie scripts carefully to understand the story and the acts of the main characters.
2. I identify the illocutionary acts and classified into illocution types based on Searle's theory (Assertive, Directive, Declarative, Commissive, Expressive)
