

ABSTRACT

Ningrum, Atin. 2017. Teaching Pronunciation to the seventh grade students of SMP Negeri 1 Jaken Pati by Using RLR (Record, Listen and Revise). Skripsi. Key Words: Teaching Pronunciation and RLR (Record, Listen and Revise).

Pronunciation is one of English components; they are the first and foremost important step in language acquisition and help the learners in spoken. In SMP Negeri 1 Jaken Pati, the seventh grade students seem not interest during teaching and learning process. They could not pronounce the word from the teacher gave. May be only one or two students could pronounce the word correctly. It is proved by the writer observation who found the student's score under the KKM. To cover the situation RLR (record, Listen and Revise) technique can be alternative technique in teaching pronunciation.

The objective of this research is to find out whether there is a significant difference between the pronunciation to the seventh grade students of SMP Negeri 1 Jaken Pati in 2016/2017 academic year before and after being taught by sing RLR (Record, Listen and Revise).

This research is experimental research which used one group pre-test and post-test. The population of this research was the seventh grade students of SMP Negeri 1 Jaken Pati in 2016/2017 academic year. The writer used cluster random sampling to take the sample and got class VII A as the sample with total of students is 22. The instrument of this research was test. The writer used oral test which consists of 15 item pair of words.

The result of this research showed that mean of pre-test is 47,8 and the standard deviation is 13,6. Meanwhile the mean of post-test is 70,8 and the standard deviation is 8,4. Based on t-test calculation the result showed t-obtain (t_0) is 13,3. With the level of significance (α) 0.05, the Degree of Freedom (df) 21, t-critical (t_t) is \pm 2.080. Therefore, the writer rejected null hypothesis (H_0) and accepted alternative hypothesis (H_a) because t-obtain (t_0) falls in the critical region.

After conducting this research, the writer concludes that RLR (Record, Listen and Revise) technique is effective to be applied in teaching pronunciation of the seventh grade students of SMP Negeri 1 Jaken Pati in 2016/2017 academic year. The writer suggests that the English teacher can make the students memorized all the pronunciation of the words.

ABSTRAK

Pengucapan adalah salah satu komponen dalam bahasa Inggris, salah satu komponen yang terpenting dalam mempelajari bahasa dan membantu dalam memahami dalam berbicara. Di SMP Negeri 1 JAken Pati, siswa kelas VII terlihat tidak tertarik selama proses belajar mengajar. Mereka tidak dapat mengucapkan kata yang diberikan oleh guru dengan benar. Itu dapat dibuktikan daro observasi penulis yang menemukan nilai siswa dibawah KKM. Untuk menatasi kondisi ini diharapkan RLR (Record, Listen and Revise) tehnik dapat diterapkan dalam pengajaran pengucapan.

Tujuan dari penelitian ini adalah untuk mengetahui apakaha ada perbedaan yang signifikan antara pemahaman membaca siswa kelas VII SMP Negeri 1 Jaken Pati pada tahun ajaran 2016/2017 sebelum dan sesudah diajar menggunakan RLR (Record, Listen and Revision).

Desain dari penelitian ini adalah penelitian eksperimental dengan menggunakan grup tunggal pre-test dan post-test. Populasi penelitian ini adalah siswa kelas VII SMP Negeri 1 Jaken Pati tahun ajaran 2016/2017. Penulis menggunakan teknik cluster random sampling untuk mengambil sample dan mendapatkan kelas VII A sebagai sample dengan jumlah siswa 22. Instrumen dalam penelitian ini adalah tes. Penulis menggunakan tes lisan yang terdiri dari 15 pasang kata.

Hasil dari penelitian ini menunjukkan nilai rata-rata pada pre-test adalah 47,8 dan standar deviasi 13,6. Sedangkan nilai rata-rata pada post-test adalah 70,8 dan standar deviasi 8,4. Berdasarkan dari hitungan t-test, hasilnya menunjukkan t-obtain (to) adalah 13,3. Dengan level signifikan (α) 0.05, degree of freedom (df) 21, dan t-table (t_t) adalah \pm 2.080. Oleh karena itu, penulis menolak null hipotesis (H₀) dan menerima alternatif hipotesis (H_a) karena t-obtain (t_o) jatuh pada wilayah kritis.

Setelah melakukan penelitian ini, penulis menyimpulkan bahwa RLR (Record, Listen and Revise) tehnik efektif untuk diterapkan dalam pengajaran pemahaman pengucapan siswa kelas VII SMP Negeri 1 Jaken Pati tahun ajaran 2016/2017. Penulis menyarankan, guru Bahasa Inggris dapat menggunakan strategi ini untuk membuat siswa mempunyai ingatan yang panjang dalam pengucapan kata.

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
